PROF. DR. ERNEST KATEMBO – ZIMBABWE

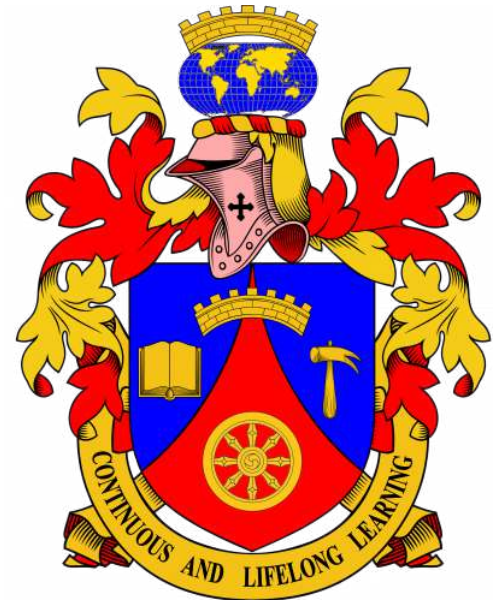
